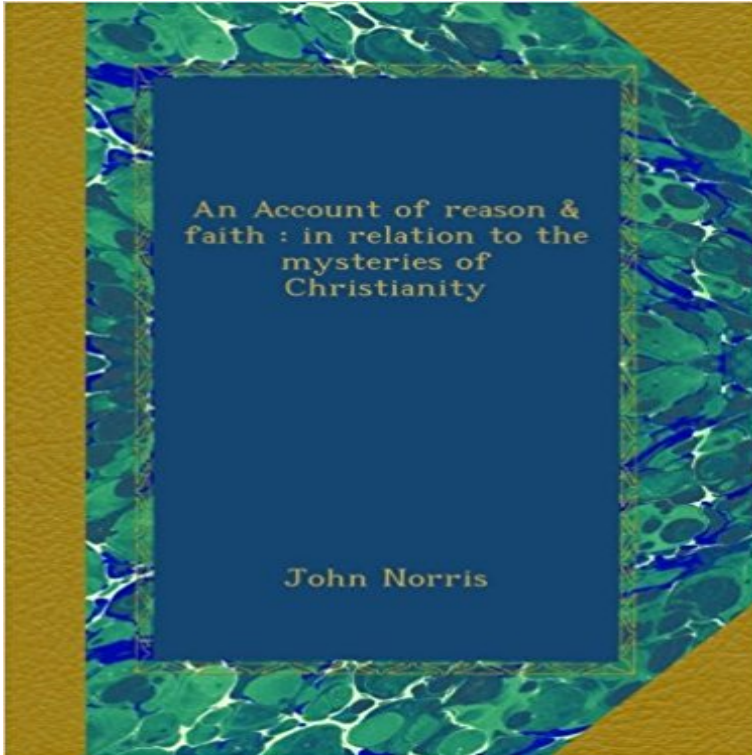


An Account of reason & faith : in relation to the mysteries of Christianity
