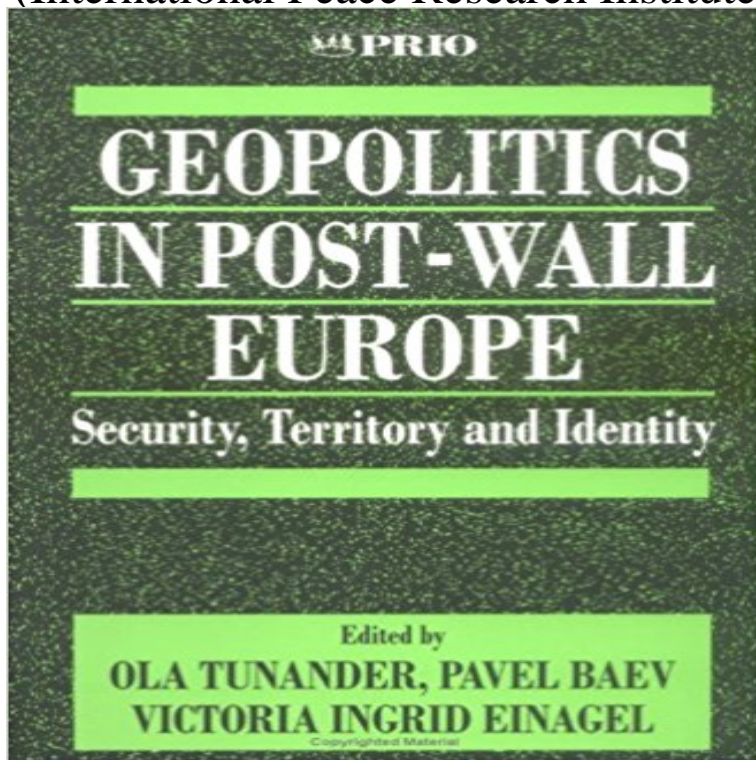


Geopolitics in Post-Wall Europe: Security, Territory and Identity (International Peace Research Institute, Oslo (PRIO))
