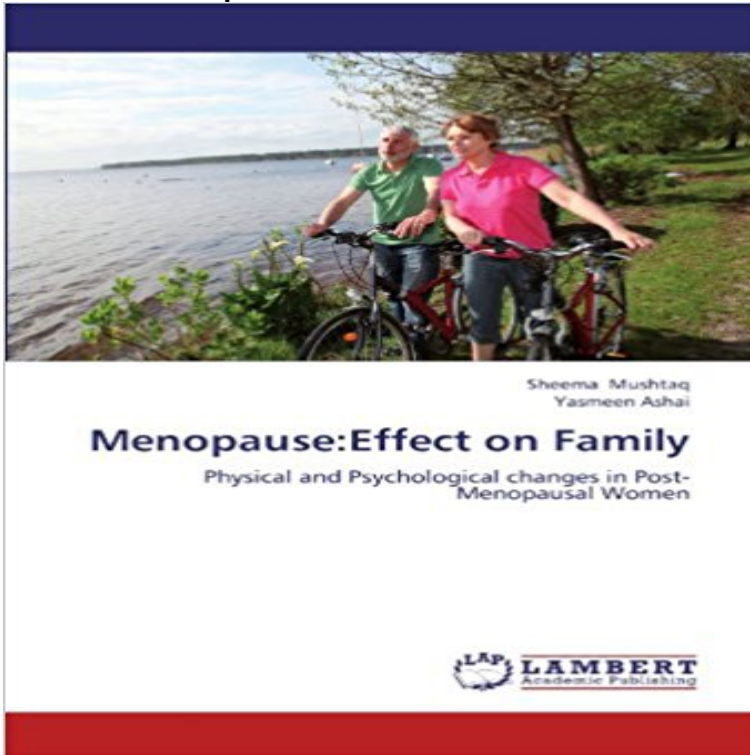


Menopause:Effect on Family: Physical and Psychological changes in Post-Menopausal Women
