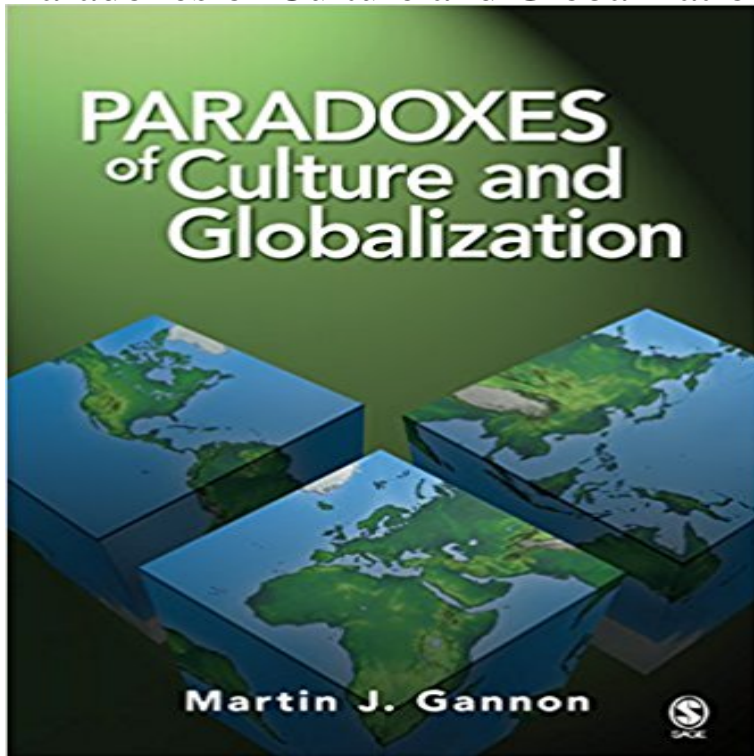


Paradoxes of Culture and Globalization
