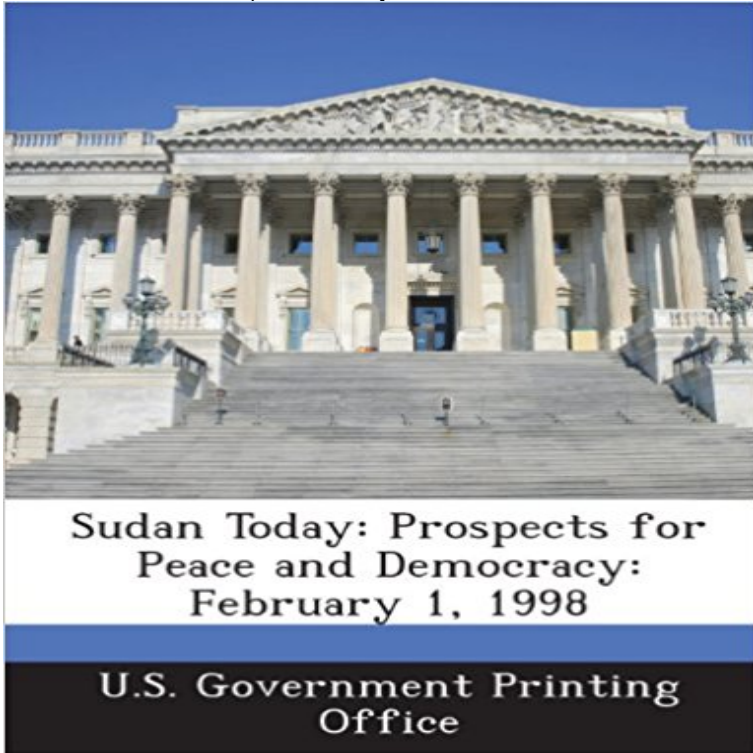


# Sudan Today: Prospects for Peace and Democracy: February 1, 1998
