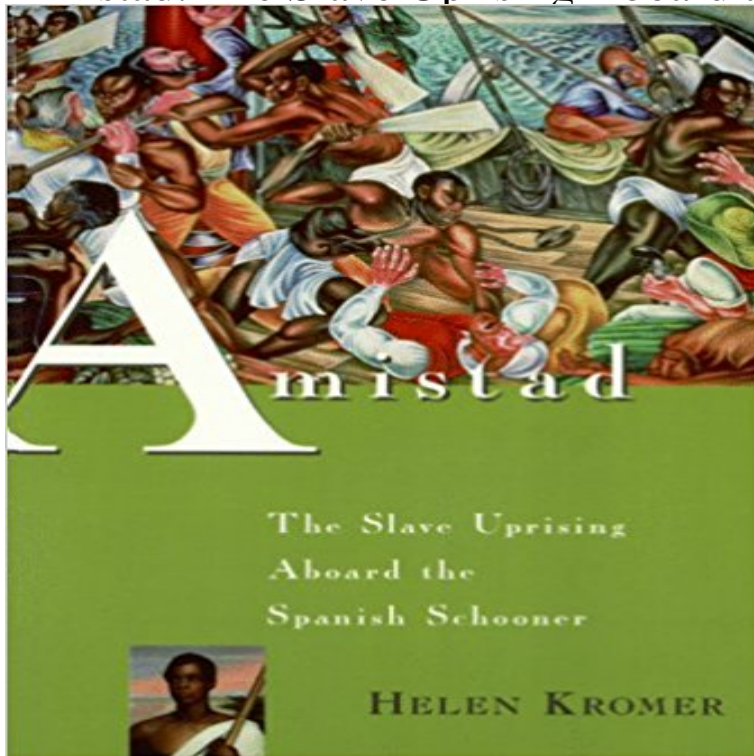


Amistad: The Slave Uprising Aboard the Spanish Schooner
