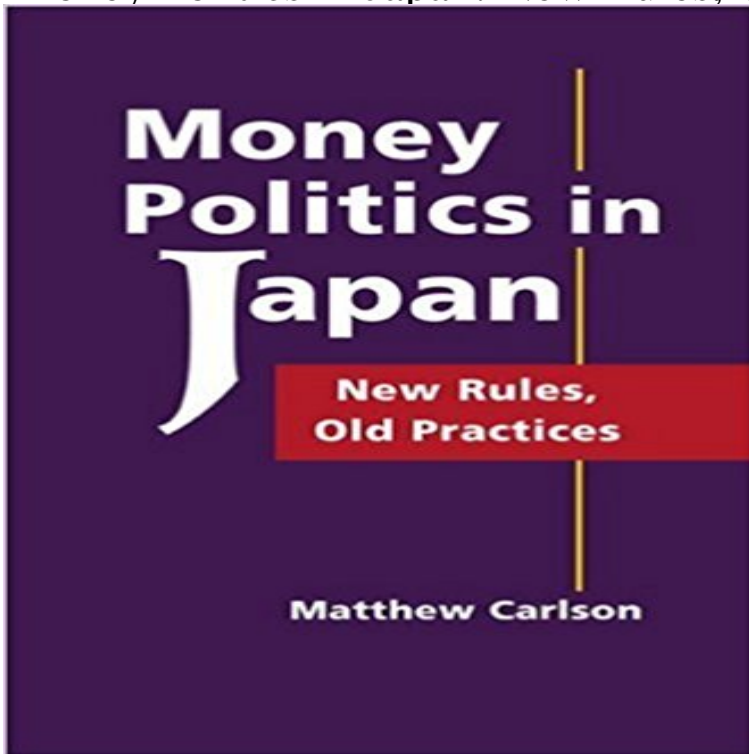


Money Politics in Japan: New Rules, Old Practices
