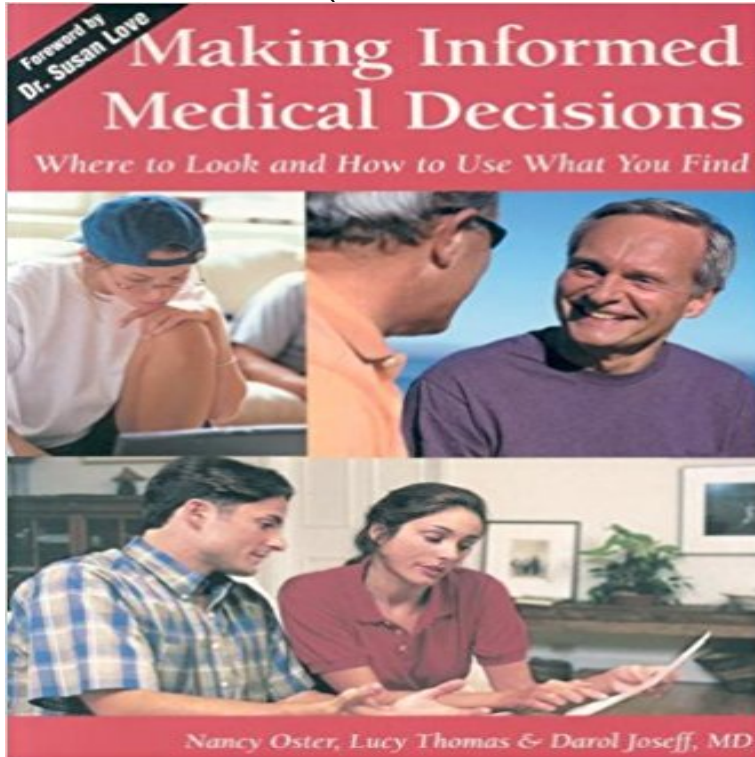


Making Informed Medical Decisions: Where to Look and How to Use What You Find (Patient Centered Guides)
