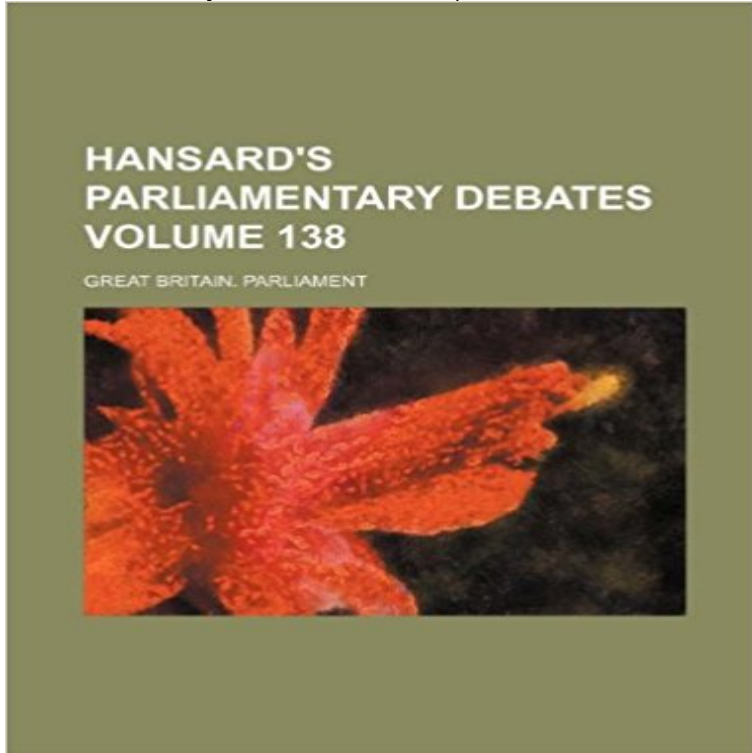

Under these circumstances their Lordships ought to hesitate before they sacrificed the permanent taxation of the country. In proportion as public necessities were great, in proportion too as the Government were lavish, it behoved Parliament to be prudent, and to put a curb upon any disposition that might be felt in any quarter, by repealing permanent taxes, in order to conciliate a popular error that was not worth the breath wasted upon it.
