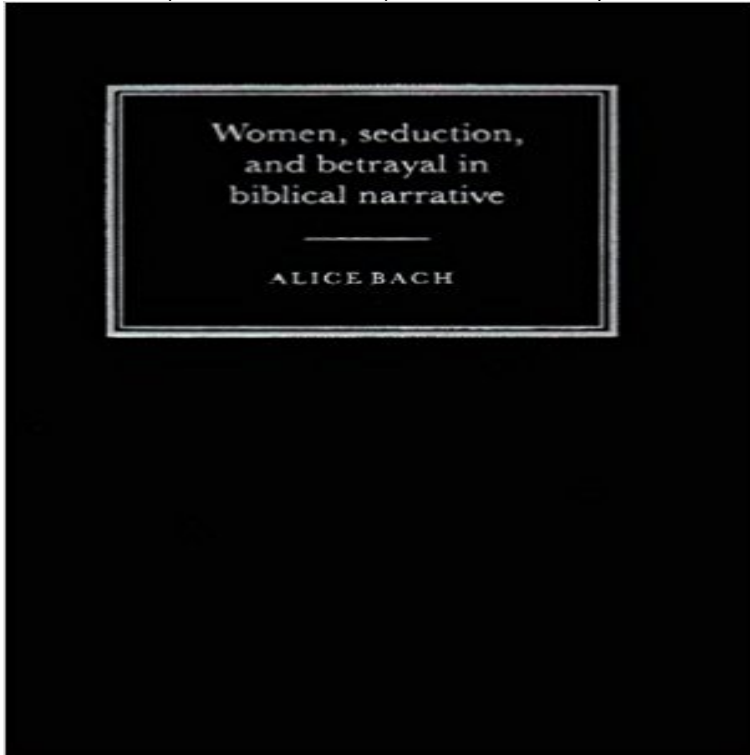


## Women, Seduction, and Betrayal in Biblical Narrative
